1. Pre-registration/payment is due **no later than Thursday, October 6th, 2022**. One entry per application. In person registration and payments may be made at the mandatory competitor meeting at the San Simeon Campground **Friday, October 7th, 2022**. No registration on the day of the event. If under 18 years of age, a parent or guardian must sign this registration.
2. A \$20 registration fee applies. Payments are accepted via Venmo until **Thursday, October, 6th 2022** or in person on **Friday, October 7th, 2020**. Venmo \$20 with "PCC, Your Name" to [@SebastianBrandhorst](https://www.venmo.com/SebastianBrandhorst). No refunds.
3. **NO SCOUTING** one month prior to the meet (starting September 8<sup>th</sup>, 2022) from Cayucos Point to Piedras Blancas SMR. 4. Diving **START TIME** is 8:30 am on Saturday October 8th, 2022. No travel time. Meet **ENDS** at 2:30 p.m. All fish must be personally presented by the diver inside the catch circle at 2:30 pm at the staging area. **NO EXCEPTIONS**. 5. This is a 20 fish meet. Scoring is 1 point per fish, 1 point per pound and is based on total aggregate weight. F&G rules will be met, or exceeded. Minimum length of 14" with specified exceptions. A fish that is a violation of state rules will be a disqualification. Sharks, rays, eels, and Mola molas are not permitted. No team loading of catch allowed. Divers are not to discard fish. No trading up. Catch limits may be adjusted as needed at the mandatory competitor meeting. 6. Fish may only be taken while freediving. Scuba, Hooka, or any other kind of breathing aid is not allowed. Divers may use muscle-loaded spearguns, Hawaiian slings, or pole spears. No powerheads.
7. Human-powered vessels only. No motor or wind-powered vessel
8. No electronic devices allowed. No note cards, dive slates, or documented landmarks allowed. 9. Please familiarize yourself with all Rules & Regulations prior to the competition at [www.fathomiers.net](http://www.fathomiers.net).
